(NOTE: Everyone is asking "WHAT HAPPENED TO THE \$2000 TOUR TO ISRAEL?" The answer is the Gas Pump has really caught up with us. The airlines have been forced to charge higher ticket prices and then tack on a daily-changing fuel surcharge. The gas prices in Israel which are well over \$7 a gallon today have forced all our contractors to go up on their prices across the board. If any savings are realized on the day we ticket passengers then we will refund whatever we can. Needless to say, the \$2000 tour is a thing of the past. Also because of the current situation in Israel, this itinerary is written very, very light. The security situation is watched and checked every day by our guide and driver and the Israeli company's security consultants. This may cause unexpected changes in our itinerary, and it is absolutely essential that everyone remain flexible. We will stick to the schedule as closely as possible and will only make changes if necessary. We have been in this business for quite some time and have one of the highest repeat rates and a perfect safety record in the Israel Tour business. With G-d's help, the trip will be both safe and exciting! We don't think you will be disappointed even for a minute, and it is super-safe to go to Israel!)

Day 1 (Dec 7)

Dallas/Fort Worth – New York – Tel Aviv – Haifa

Travel from your home to DFW where you will be met by Sam Peak, your host, and then board your Continental flight to the Land of the Bible. (*Special note: your domestic flight arrangements to DFW are your responsibility. We will assist you if we can.*) 🇮🇱

Day 2 (Dec 8)

Ben Gurion – Tel Aviv

We arrive in the morning at the historic Ben Gurion Airport. Following passport control and luggage collection we are met by our guide and driver for some immediate touring and then transfer to our luxurious hotel. Tonight we stay in the beautiful and historic city of Tel Aviv on the Mediterranean coast. 🇮🇱

Day 3 (Dec 9)

Up the Golden Coast – Akko (Acre)

After a world-famous Israeli buffet breakfast we begin a full and interesting day by visiting a “holy” site in Tel Aviv (Independence Hall), and then checking out the golden coast all the way Akko where we will stay overnight in this historic coastal fortress. 🇮🇱

Day 4 (Dec 10)

Akko – Tsfat (Safed)

There are many interesting sites and experiences planned today. There is no limit to the possibilities. It is Friday and we must arrive early to prepare for the Shabbat. Hopefully Rabbi Richman (the International Director of the Temple Institute) will be joining us for our first Shabbat of the trip. We will spend the Shabbat in one of the four holy cities of Israel, Tsfat. Tsfat (Safed) is known as the mystical city of the kabbalists, and we will have a few interesting days in this very interesting city. Shabbat Shalom! 🇮🇱

Day 5 (Dec 11)

Shabbat in Tsfat

It is Shabbat and a free day – relax, rest and enjoy it. Shabbat Shalom. 🇮🇱

Day 6 (Dec 12)

Tsfat – Ramat HaGolan – Tiberias

Shavua Tov (good new week to you) – If Rabbi Richman is able to be with us, he will lead us on a very special tour of the Mystical City. Later we will take a short tour of the strategic Golan Heights before heading for the beautiful Kinneret (Sea of Galilee) for an overnight stay in the holy city of Tiberias. 🇮🇱

Day 7 (Dec 13)

Tiberias – Beit Shean – Dead Sea

We begin to work our way south all the way to luxury spa hotel on the Dead Sea. There will be many exciting sites to see on the way. 🇮🇱

Day 8 (Dec 14)

Masada – Ein Gedi – Up to Yerushalayim (Jerusalem)

Today we visit Ein Gedi (King David's hideout in the Negev). Before the day is out we ascend up to Jerusalem, the City of the Great King! We will stay for the next 5 nights in our home away from home, the Dan Panorama which is conveniently located near both the modern exciting city and the old city. 🇮🇱

Day 9 (Dec 15)

Jerusalem – Temple Institute – Burnt House...

We are in Jerusalem and the possibilities are endless as we begin to explore the modern and ancient city. To wake up in Jerusalem is indescribable! It will be a full day as we try to fit in a lot of things, like the Western Wall with the fascinating Southern Excavations of the Temple Mount, plus the Temple Institute and hopefully maybe ascend the Temple Mount with Rabbi Chaim Richman. 🕍

Day 10 (Dec 16)

Hebron – Gush Etsion – Herodian

We take a trek outside Jerusalem today to pay our respects to Abraham and Sarah, Isaac and Rebecca, and Jacob and Leah (not to mention Adam and Eve) as we visit the Cave of Machpelah, the strategic area of Gush Etsion, and the fascinating Herodian fortress. 🕍

Day 11 (Dec 17)

Jerusalem – Yad VaShem

We will continue getting to know Jerusalem today and pay our respects to the 6 million at Yad VaShem, and to the fallen heroes of Israel at Mt Hertzl. It's hard to believe but it is Yom Shishi (Friday) already. Shabbat Shalom. 🕍

Day 12 (Dec 18)

Jerusalem – Shabbat Shalom – Free Day

Shabbat, a free day. Relax and enjoy the holy atmosphere of this holiest of holy cities. Sleep late. Take your own walk. Whatever you like. 🕍

Day 13 (Dec 19)

Shomron – Judea

We say farewell to Jerusalem and make another unusual excursion into the territories north of Jerusalem. With G-d's help, Rabbi Richman will accompany us to the settlement of Itamar close to Mt Gerizim and Mt Eval. We will stay our last night in the settlement of Ariel. 🕍

Day 14 (Dec 20)

Latrun – Tel Aviv – Ben Gurion

Today is our last day, and it is a long day (we apologize). After we leave the hotel in Ariel today, we will end at the Ben Gurion airport to begin our journey back to the states. Tonight we gather for a farewell dinner and later our late-night flight. It is hard to believe it is over. But this trip will, in a sense, never be over, for we have walked the Promised Land and we will never be the same. 🕍

Day 15 (Dec 21)

Ben Gurion – USA

Arrival in the USA for transfer to our connecting flights back home. But always remember, you have a new home now: ISRAEL! 🕍
